> AN ORDINANCE UPDATING TITLE 9 BUILDING REGULATIONS, CHAPTER 1 BUILDING CODES, SECTION 9-1-1-1 ‘BUILDING CODE', SECTION 9-1-1-2 ‘RESIDENTIAL CODE', SECTION 9-1-1-3 ‘FIRE CODE', SECTION 9-1-1-4 MECHANICAL CODE', SECTION 9-1-1-5 ‘PLUMBING CODE', SECTION 9-1-1-6 ‘FUEL GAS CODE', SECTION 9-1-1-7 ‘ENERGY CONSERVATION CODE', SECTION 9-1-1-8 ‘ELECTRICAL CODE', SECTION 9-1-1-9 ‘PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE', SECTION 9-1-3 (N) ‘CONTRACTOR FEE'; PROVIDING FOR A CUMULATIVE CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY PROVISION; PROVIDING FOR AN ENABLING DATE OF ENFORCEMENT; PROVIDING FOR THE CITY SECRETARY TO HAVE THE CONTENTS OF THIS ORDINANCE PUBLISHED AND POSTED IN THE CITY OF ALAMO’S CODE OF ORDINANCES; AND INSTRUCTING THE CITY SECRETARY TO PUBLISH THE CAPTION OF THIS ORDINANCE IN A NEWSPAPER OF LOCAL CIRCULATION IN ACCORDANCE TO PROTOCOL

WHEREAS, The City of Alamo, Texas adopted technical building codes and associated regulations that will provide guidance as to the minimum requirements of buildings and other associated structures within the city limits; and,

WHEREAS, The City of Alamo, Texas understands that, from time to time, such building related codes and regulations will need to be updated to have its resulting structures comply with the most current building code requirements; thus, being a continual improvement of the structural stock in Alamo, Texas; and,

WHEREAS, The City's current Code of Ordinances require that the City Secretary's office be equipped with 3 copies of five (5) of the Codes desired to be updated and one (1) copy of the others; but since such Codes are now commonly available on the internet, paying and keeping so many sets of said Codes is deemed redundant and financially un-necessary; and,

WHEREAS, It has also been brought to the City's attention that there has been State legislation that needs to be logically assimilated into the City's codes as it relates to registration fees of certain contractors; and,

WHEREAS, The City of Alamo, Texas has discerned that it is indeed in the City's best interests to update the code requirements as specifically outlined herein.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ALAMO, COUNTY OF HIDALGO, STATE OF TEXAS, THAT:

Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the building code-of the City of Alamo, Texas, for the regulating and governing the-conditions-and maintenance-of all propery, buildings and structures; by providing the standards for supplied-utilities and facilities and-other physical things and conditions-essential to-ensure that structures are safe, sanitary and fit for oceupation and use; and-condemnation-of buildings and struetures unfit for human-occupancy and use and the demolition-of such structures as therein provided; providing for the issuance-of permits and collection of fees therefore; and-each and all of the regulations, provisions penalties, eonditions, and temp-of said building code-on file in the-office-of the eity secretary re hereby referred to, adopted, and made a par hereof, as if fully set-out in-this-section, with the-additions, insentions, deletions, and-changes, if any, preseribed in this section. The International Building Code 2021 edition is hereby adopted for the purposes expressed in said Code, with consideration given to any amendments specified in (B) below.
2. Section 9-1-1-2 (A) 'Residential Code' be amended as follows: "Adeption: That a Eertain-document, three (3) copies of which are-on file-in-the-office-of the-city secretary of the city-of Alamo, being marked and designated as the internationat Fesidential-code, 2012 edition, including appendix 5 manufactured housing used as dwellings; appendix Fradon-control methods; appendix-G-swimming pools, spas and hot tubs; appendix H-patio-covers; appendix--existing buildings-and-structures; appendix K-sound transmission-as published by the International-Code-Council be and is hereby adopted as the residential code-of the city-of Alame, Texas, for regulating and governing the-construction, alkeration, movement, enlargement, replacement, Fepair, equipment, location, removal, and-demolition of detached-one-and-wo-family dwellings and multiple single family dwellings (townhouses) not more than three 3) stories in height with separate means-of egress and herein provided; providing for the issuance-of permits and collection-of fees therefore; and each and all of the Fegulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms-of said residential-code-on file
in the-office-of the city seeretary arehereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof, ws if fully set out in this section, with the additions, insertions, deletions, and changes, if any, preseribed in this-section. The International Residential Code 2018 edition is hereby adopted for the purposes expressed in said Code with consideration given to any amendments specified in (B) below.
3. Section 9-1-1-3 (A) 'Fire Code' be amended as follows: Adeption: Thatan document, three (3) copies of which areon file in the office of the city secretaryof the sity of Alamo, being marked and designated as the international fire code, 2012 edition, including appendix- $B$ fire-flow requirements for buildings; appendix $C$ fire hydrant locations and distribution; appendix-D fire-apparatus access roads; appendix E hazard-categories; appendix-5 hazard ranking; appendix G cryogenic fluids - weight and volume equivalents; appendix H hazardous materials management plan (HMMAP) and hazardous materials inventory statement (HMAS) instructions; appendix Ifire protection-systems - noncompliant conditions; appendix - building information sign; as published by the International Code Council, beand is hereby adopted as the fire code-of the city of Alamo, Tewas, regulating and governing the-safeguarding-of the life and propery from fire and explosions hazards arising from the storage, handling, and use of hazardous substances, materials and-deviees, and from conditions hazardous to lifeor property in the oceupancy of buildings and premises as herein provided; providine for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefore; and each and alt of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said fire code on file in the office of the city secretary are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereef, as if fully set-out in this section, with the additions, insertions, deletions, and changes, if any, prescribed in this section. The International Fire Code 2018 edition is hereby adopted for the purposes expressed in said Code with consideration given to any amendments specified in (B) below.
4. Section 9-1-1-4 (A) 'Mechanical Code' be amended as follows: Adoption: That-z certain doeument, one-original of which is on file in the-office-of the eity secretary-of the city-of Alamo, being marked and designated as the international mechanical code, 2003 -edition, as published by the International Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the mechanical code of the city-of Alamo, Texas, for regulating and governing the design, construction, quality of materials, erection, installation, alteration, repair, locetion, relocation, replacement, addition to, use or maintenance ef mechanical systems as herein provided; providing for the issuanceof permits-and collection of fees therefore; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms-of said mechaniealcodo on file in the office of the city secretary
are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof, as iffully set-out in this setiof. The International Mechanical Code 2021 edition is hereby adopted for the purposes expressed in said Code with consideration given to any amendments specified in (B) below.
5. Section 9-1-1-5 (A) 'Plumbing Code' be amended as follows: Adoption: That a-eertain document, three (3) copies of which are on file in the office-of the city-secretary-of the city of Alame, being marked-and-designated as the international plumbing-code, 2012 edition, including appendix-A system layout illustrations; appendix-B tables for pressure-distribution-systems; as-published-by the-International-Code-Council, be-and is hereby adopted as the plumbing code-of the City-of Alamo, Texas, regulating and governing the design, construction, quality of materials, erection, installation, alteration, repair, location, relocation, replacement, addition to, use or maintenance of plumbing systems as herein provided; providing for the-iscuance-of permits and collection-of fees therefore; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms-of said plumbing-coleon file in the office-of the-city-secretary are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part thereof, as iffully setout in this section, with the additions, insertions, deletions, and changes, if any, prescribed in this section. The International Plumbing Code 2021 edition is hereby adopted for the purposes expressed in said Code with consideration given to any amendments specified in (B) below.
6. Section 9-1-1-6 (A) 'Fuel Gas Code' be amended as follows: Adoption: That a-certain document, three (3) eopies-of which are-on-file-in the-office-ofthe-Gity-Secretary-of the City-of Alam, being marked and-designated as the-International Fuel-Gas-Code, z012-edition, including appendix $A$, Sizing and Capaeieies-of Gas-piping; appendix B, Sizing of Venting Systems-Serving Applinaces Equipped With Draft Hoods, Categoryl, Appliances-and-Appliances Listed for Use With Type-B-Vents; as published-by the thernational-Code-Council, be and is hereby adopted as the-Fuel Gas Code-of the-City of Alame, Texas, for regulating and governing fuel gas-systems and gas fired appliances as herein provided; providing for the issuance of permits-and-collection-of fees therefore; and each and all of the regulations, provisions penalties, conditions and terms of said-Fuel Gas-code on file in th-Office-of the-City Secretary are hereby referred to, adopted, and-made a par hereof, as if fulty-set-out in this-section, with the additions, insentions, deletions, and changes, if any, preseribed in this section. The International Fuel Gas Code 2018 edition is hereby adopted for the purposes expressed in said Code with consideration given to any amendments specified in (B) below.
7. Section 9-1-1-7 (A) 'Energy Conservation Code' be amended as follows: Adoption: That a certain document, one coy of which is on file in theoffice ofthe-City lnspector fo the-City-of Alamo, being marked and designated as the Internationa! Energy Gonservation Code, 2015 edition, as published by the International-Code-Council, be and is hereby adopted as the Energy Conservation Code-of the City-Of Alamo, Texas, Fegulating and governing energy efficient building envelopes and installation-of energy efficient mechanieal, lighting and power systems as herein provided; providing for the issuance of permits and collection-of fees therefore; and leach and all of the Fegulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said Energy Conservation Godeon file in the-office of the City Inspector are hereby referred to, adopted, and made - part hereof, as if fully set out in this section, with the additions, insertions, deletions, and changes, if any, prescribed in this section. The International Energy Conservation Code 2021 edition is hereby adopted for the purposes expressed in said Code with consideration given to any amendments specified in (B) below.
8. Section 9-1-1-8 (A) 'Electrical Code' be amended as follows: Adoption: The 2017 $\underline{2020}$ edition of the National Electrical Code is hereby adopted by reference.
9. Section 9-1-1-9 (A) 'Property Maintenance Code' be amended as follows: Adoption: That a certain document, three (3) copies of which areon file in the Office of the City Secretary of the City of Alamo, being marked and designated as the International Propery Maintenance Code, 2012 edition, as published by the International Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the Property Maintenance codeof the City-0fAlamo, Texas, for regulating and governing the conditions and maintenance of all property, buildings and struetures; by providing the standards for supplied utilities and facilities and other physical things and conditions essential to ensure that structures are safe, sanitary and fit for oceupation and use; and the condemnation-of buildings and-structures unfit for human-ceupancy and use, and the demolition of such existing structures as herein provided; providing for the issuance-of permits-and collection of fees therefore; and ach and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said property maintenance code on file in the-office of the city secretary are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof, as iffully set out in thislegislation, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, preseribedin this-section. The International Property Maintenance Code 2018 edition is hereby adopted for the purposes expressed in said Code with consideration given to any amendments specified in (B) below.
10. Section 9-1-3 'Building Code Permit Fees' $(\mathrm{N})(1)$ and $(\mathrm{N})(2)$ requiring a registration fee and renewal fee from contractors, e.g., plumbers, AC contractors, master electricians) is hereby deleted in its entirety due to State legislation; and shall be replaced by the following: Due to State legislation as it relates to Texas' Occupation Code's references to prohibit or inhibit registration fees to plumbers, AC contractors, and master electricians, the City of Alamo will not levy registration fees to such identified occupations; however, should future legislation be adopted to once again allow for such registration fees, the City of Alamo reserves its right for such re-consideration.
11. Should there be any regulation, provision, phrase, section or similar measure be determined to be unconstitutional or deemed invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is declared that all other remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.
12. Should there be a regulation, provision, section or similar measure that may be in conflict with any provision, policy, or regulation as set forth by this ordinance, then the provisions of this ordinance shall supersede all others.
13. This ordinance and its ordained provisions, regulations, and measures shall be effective on October 1, 2022 (12:01 a.m.), as enabled upon the signature by the Mayor of the City of Alamo, Texas.
14. The City Secretary of the City of Alamo, Texas is hereby instructed to forward the signed ordinance to the City's Codifying firm so that the contents may be promptly published in the City of Alamo's Code of Ordinances.
15. The City Secretary of the City of Alamo, Texas is hereby instructed to publish the caption of this ordinance in a newspaper of local circulation in accordance to policy and protocol.
