

Response:

Yes, the Contractor will be allowed to work at night but any work that generates too much noise, such as sandblasting is not allowed.

3. Will Contractor be required to shroud (cover) the clarifier during coating process.

Response:

Specifications outline the necessary procedures and protective measures during the coating application. Please note that the coating process is sensitive to the environment in terms of humidity, temperature, dust, and debris. Therefore, the expectation is that the Contractor will shroud or enclose the basin to ensure proper application.
