I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Mayor J.R. Garza called the regular meeting held on Monday, November 17th, 2025 to order at 6:00 p.m. at the City of Alamo Municipal Building.

A. Pledge of Allegiance

City Manager Robert L. Salinas led the Pledge of Allegiance.

B. Invocation

Mayor Pro – Tem Roel Leon Moreno Jr, led the Invocation.

C. Consideration and Action on an Ordinance to Canvassing the Election Results of the City November 4th, 2025 General Election.

City Manager Robert L. Salinas stated that he would be reading out the Ordinance # 213-11-25. Pursuant to the ordinance of the City of Alamo and pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Texas Election code, the canvassing board certifies the following are true and correct results, to wit: That there were cast at said election 1,985 legal and valid votes.

- 1. Commissioner Place 1 Okie Salinas **1,506***
- 2. Commissioner Place 3 Roel Leon Moreno Jr. **1,417***
- 3. Municipal Judge Celia Garcia **1,051** and Diana Martinez **864***

Said election was duly called; that notice of said election was given in accordance with the law; and that the canvass of the votes cast in said elections and returns thereof were made in accordance with the law. Pursuant to the ordinances of the City of Alamo and applicable provisions of the Texas Election Code:

- 1. Commissioner Place One: Okie Salinas received a majority of votes cast to be elected Commissioner Place One of the City of Alamo and shall commence his term of office upon execution and filing of the Oath of Office for Commissioner Place One of the City of Alamo, Hidalgo County, Texas.*
- 2. Commissioner Place Three: Roel "Leon" Moreno Jr. received a majority of votes cast to be elected Commissioner Place Three of the City of Alamo and shall commence his term of office upon execution and filing of the Oath of Office for Commissioner Place Three of the City of Alamo, Hidalgo County, Texas.*
- 3. Municipal Judge: Celia Garcia received a majority of votes cast to be elected Municipal Judge of the City of Alamo and shall commence his term of office upon execution and filing of the Oath of Office for Municipal Judge of the City of Alamo, Hidalgo County, Texas.*

Passed and Approved by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Alamo, Hidalgo County, Texas, on a Special meeting called and held in Alamo City Hall on this the 17th day of November 2025, held in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.

Commissioner Pete Morales motioned to approve, Commissioner AJ Garcia seconded. Motion carried.

D. Consideration and Action to Administer the Oath of Office to the Newly Elected Officials.

Judge Jerry Munoz spoke on the victory of Oscar Salinas and administered the oath of office for Commissioner Place 1 for the City of Alamo

Commissioner Oscar Salinas recited his oath of office and thanked the community for their support and prayers.

Judge AJ Garcia spoke on the victory of Roel Leon Moreno Jr. and administered the oath of office for Commissioner Place 3 for the City of Alamo

Mayor Pro Tem Roel Leon Moreno Jr. recited his oath of office and thanked the community for their support and prayers.

Judge Albert Garcia spoke on the victory of Celia Garcia and administered the oath of office for Municipal Judge

Municipal Judge Celia Garcia recited his oath of office and thanked the community for their support.

Commissioner Pete Morales motioned to approve, and Commissioner Okie Salinas seconded. Motion carried.
